## **AUSTRALIAN COMMUNICATIONS AND MEDIA AUTHORITY**

## DRAFT Target Reduction Order STV-TRO-00103 made under subsection 130ZY(3) of the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992*

## 1. Interpretation

In this instrument:

ACMA means the Australian Communications and Media Authority

Act means the Broadcasting Services Act 1992

Applicant means Selectra Pty Ltd (ACN 065 367 526)

**Application** means the target reduction order application made on 23 December 2020 in respect of the Service

Service means CMT

Specified Eligible Period means 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021.

## 2. Target Reduction

Under subsection 130ZY(3) of the Act, the ACMA:

- (a) having considered the written representations made by the Applicant in the Application, the supporting evidence submitted with the Application [and the submissions received during the consultation period from...] <sup>1</sup>; and
- (b) being satisfied that a refusal to make the target reduction order would impose an unjustifiable hardship on the Applicant;

*ORDERS* that, for the Specified Eligible Period, the reduced annual captioning target for the Applicant in respect of the Service will be 17.5%.
