

Formal Warning under subsection 122(2) of the *Telecommunications Act 1997*

TO: Telstra Corporation Limited, ACN 051 775 556

OF: Level 28, 242 Exhibition Street, Melbourne VIC 3000

I, Linda Caruso, delegate of the Australian Communications and Media Authority (the **ACMA**) being satisfied that Telstra Corporation Limited ACN 051 775 556 (**Telstra**) has contravened the Industry Code C564:2020 Mobile Phone Base Station Deployment (the **Deployment Code**), **HEREBY** issue a formal warning to Telstra under subsection 122(2) of the *Telecommunications Act 1997* (the **Act**) in respect to the Deployment Code.

Details of the contraventions

- 1. On 19 December 2022, the ACMA commenced an investigation into Telstra's alleged contraventions of the Deployment Code.
- 2. The investigation was in respect to the proposed site installation of a mobile phone base station located adjacent to 30 Archer Street, Concord NSW 2137.
- 3. As a licensed telecommunications carrier that installs and operates mobile phone radiocommunications infrastructure, which is used, intended to be used, or capable of being used to supply public mobile telecommunications services, Telstra is a participant in a section of the telecommunications industry to which the Deployment Code applies.
- 4. Upon completion of the investigation, the ACMA is satisfied that Telstra contravened clauses:
 - i) 5.2.4 of the Deployment Code by failing to effectively identify and notify a community sensitive location.
 - ii) 5.2.5 (a) of the Deployment Code by failing to accurately identify the site position of the proposed site in the site map located in notification to interested and affected parties.
 - iii) 5.2.9 (a) and (b) of the Deployment Code by failing to ensure that all its obligations were met prior to commencing construction at the proposed site location.
